## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 Rules

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020). If there is a conflict between languages the German text will take precedence.
- 1.2 Additional rules: The prescriptions of the Austrian Sailing Federation will apply, Class Rules oft the german J70 class association will apply [DP], Sailing Instructions of the Austrian Sailing Federation (OeSV) 2018 will apply, Additional Sailing Instructions from the YCB will apply and This NoR will apply.
- **1.3** The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.
- **1.4** If the class ruls do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for personal flotation devices.
- 1.5 The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the anti-doping rules of the Austrian Bundessportorganisation shall apply. For doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate at the regatta.

## 2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. [DP]

## 3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the J70 class which are registrated by an World Sailing recognized authority, match the german class requirements and will be be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1.500.000.
- **3.2** All coxswains must be a member of an association organisation, a OeSV single member or a member of an World Sailing recognized national organisation.
- **3.3** All coxswains must own at least one of the following licenses: BFA Junior, BFA Binnen, BFA FB 1 or an corresponding licence of an international organisation.
- **3.4** Eligible boats may enter by completing the online form under www.ycb.at Regatten 2018 until entry closing.
- 3.5 Entry closing is on Sunday 27th May 2018.
- **3.6** Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Additional fee of EUR 60,- until end of registration.
- 3.7 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Minimum 9 boats until entry closing.

#### 4 Fees

The fee ist EUR 120,- in cash at registration or via bank transfer.

#### 5 Registration and Sailing Instructions

Registration and distribution of sailing instructions: Friday 1st June 2018 from 08:30 to 10:00 in the YCB clubhouse.

#### 6 Skipper Briefing

At Friday 1st June 2018 at 10:00 in the YCB clubhouse.

#### 7 First start

First start at Friday 1st June 2018 at 11:00.

#### 8 Last Start

No start after Sunday 3rd June 2018 14:00.

#### 9 Course

Standard courses with a target time of 40 minutes will be sailed.

#### 10 Scoring

Up to 12 races. If there are 12 races the highest three will not be scored. If 8, 9, 10 or 11 races will be sailed, the highest two will not be scored. If 4, 5, 6 or 7 races will be sailed, the highest score will not be scored. Maximum 5 races a day. The Low-Point-System of Appendix A will apply.

### 11 Berthing

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour. Free boat craning for regatta boats after announcement E-Mail ycb-hafenmeister@gmx.at or 0043-664-73988363. [DP]

#### 12 Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

#### 13 Prizes

Prizes for the first third entered boats until entry closing.

#### 14 Disclaimer of Liability

Participants sail at their own risk (RRS4). The organizers and all entrusted with racing organization, are not liable for any loss, damage or injury which may occur to persons, yachts or otherwise. This applies on the water and on land.

#### 15 Insurance

Boats must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 1.500.000.
